SiteAudit Version 2.4 Is First Managed Print Services Tool to Offer Adaptive Monitoring for Mid-Market and Enterprise Level Environments

(www.netaphor.com), a provider of managed print services software, today introduced an upgraded version of SiteAudit. SiteAudit version 2.4 introduces Adaptive Fleet Technology (AFT), the industry's first adaptive fleet monitoring technology. AFT automatically adapts data collection processes to fit any size environment, an important capability for enterprise-size organizations. It eliminates the task of scheduling data collections and minimizes network traffic. With AFT and SiteAudit's agent-less architecture, no client agents are required, it becomes the easiest and most accepted managed print services solution to deploy and maintain.

In addition the new version introduces threshold rules for consumables and print volume alerting. Threshold rules consists of a set of conditions that when met alert IT administrators or fleet managers before problems occur. Its flexible configuration enables a range of conditions from consumable levels, toner coverage to consumable installation date or from scanner page volume to large-size color copier volume. As an example fleet managers will know when an office multifunction printer is being used as a production scanner; or when customers have exceeded page volumes on their contract commitments.

SiteAudit 2.4 also extends notification capabilities by adding control over alert timing, such as specifying alerts only during contracted service-level periods, and it expands asset and contact data in notifications to improve diagnostic and response times.

"Adaptive Fleet Technology is an important differentiator when customer's compare SiteAudit to other managed print service tools. The benefit of adaptive monitoring is measured by the peace-of-mind administrators feel when their networks are not burdened by extra traffic," said Rakesh Mahajan, CEO of Netaphor. "It really adds an IT acceptance level by not possible from other solutions."

SiteAudit utilizes Netaphor's agentless print management technology and is ideally suited for medium to enterprise customers. With the ability to reduce print costs by up to 30 percent, SiteAudit offers potential savings in the areas of hardware (8%), consumables (5%), service/help desk (5%), operations (5%), administration (4%) and customer management (3%).
